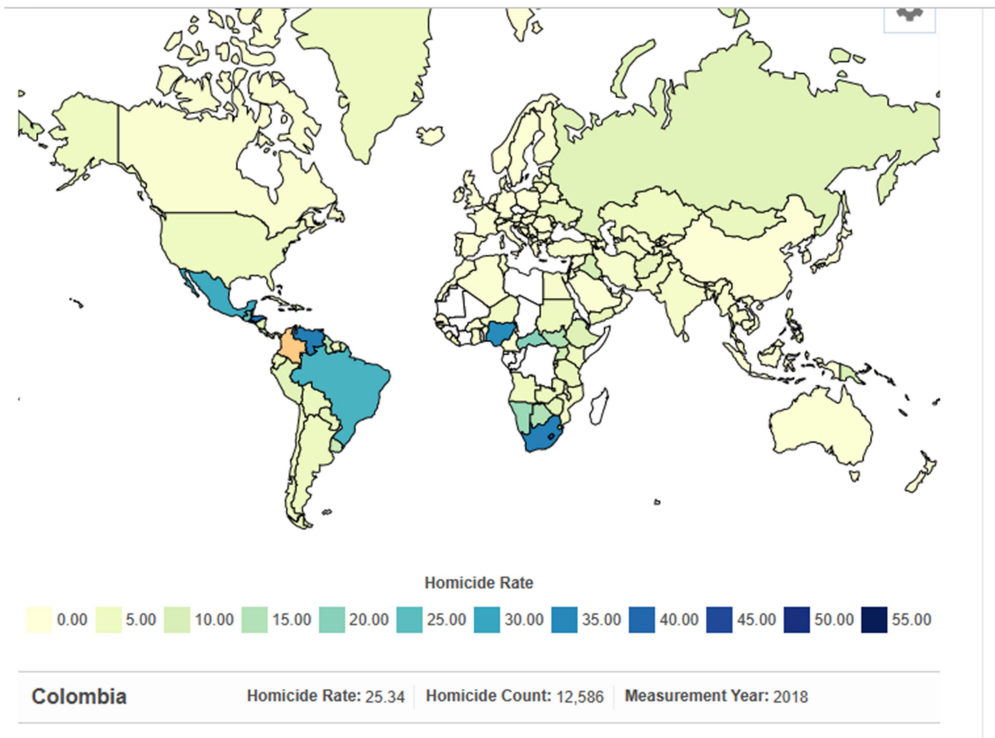
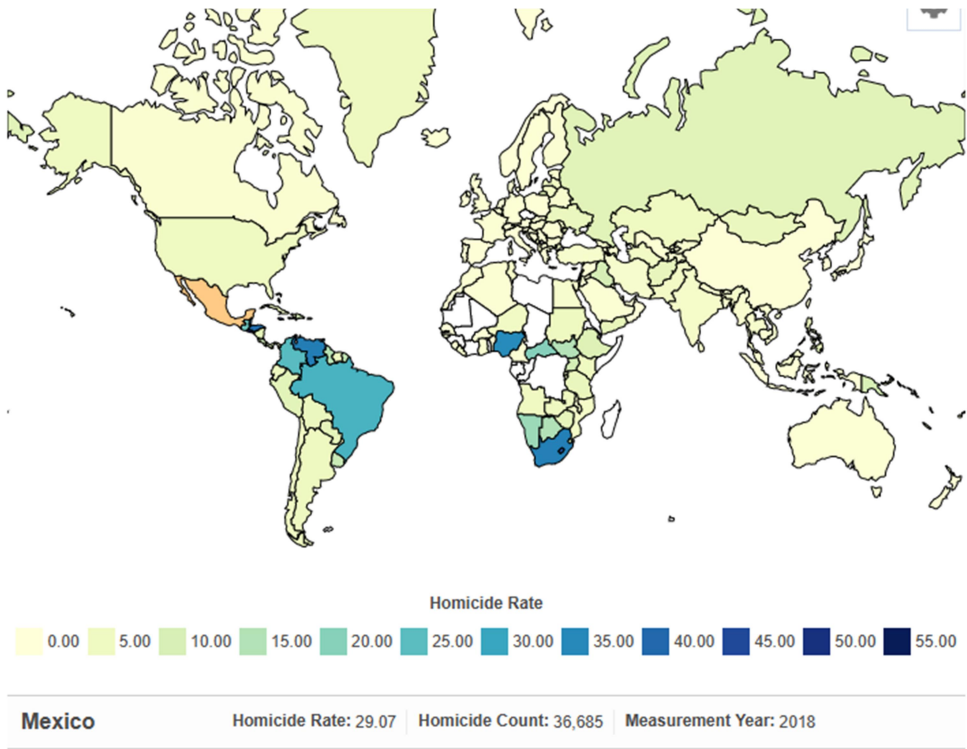
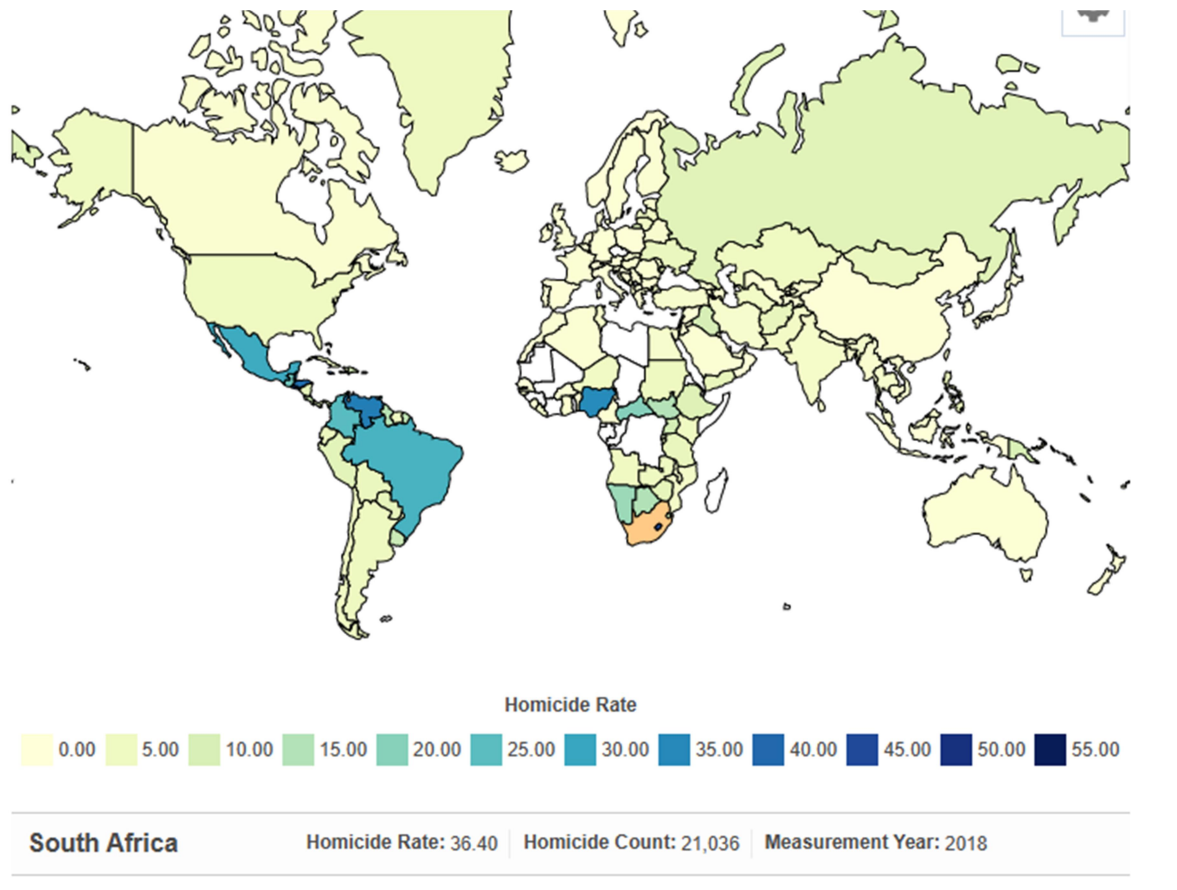

Assassination Culture in SA

Aug 2021

Babita Deokaran, mowed down after dropping child at school, was a witness in the R332m PPE scandal.

January 2022

Thirty-six-year-old Simiso Gumede was shot and killed inside a supermarket in January.

Police say his assailants opened fire on him at a petrol station.

Gumede abandoned his car and ran into a nearby shop.

KZN police spokesperson Thenjiswa Ngcobo says the suspects first appeared in the Umlazi Magistrate's Court last week.

The suspects decided to hand themselves in on 9 June 2022 when they realised that the Organised Crime and Special Investigations and Tracking Task Team was minimising their space.

Oct 18, 2022

About 10.18am: Shooting outside a petrol station on Kingsway Street in Warner Beach. "When medics arrived on the scene, they found an adult male seated in the driver's side of his bullet-riddled car," Herbst said.

“The man had sustained multiple high-calibre gunshot wounds throughout his body.

October 21, 2022.

Brijmohan was shot and killed in Amanzimtoti on his property in October 2022. A surveillance video of the incident showed two men walking towards Brijmohan. As he turned and walked to meet them, he was shot at point-blank range in the face and body, dying at the scene.

November 10, 2022

THE man that was shot and killed at Seadoone Mall on Wednesday, November 9, at about 17:00, has been identified as 57-year-old William Kunene. Peak time at the mall, car park filled up with shoppers, opened fire with 9mm, then second shooter exited the vehicle to deliver the coup de grace with an AK47

Tuesday, 21 March 2023

Brandon “Puff” Kalicharan, his wife Jeconiah “Jackie,” and their daughter Jecaida were killed in their Amarok van on Tuesday, 21 March in Springfield, Durban by unknown attackers. Brandon – nicknamed “Puff” – was the alleged leader of the 11th Street Gang in Chatsworth.

24 Mar 2023

Murder of five people in three separate drive-by shooting incidents on Thursday, two in Tongaat on the North Coast and one in Amanzimtoti on the South Coast.

Updated March 28, 2023

Santaco in KZN says last week's deadly shooting in Tongaat could be linked to a feud between illegal taxi operators that were recently removed

Tuesday, April 4 2023

There seems to be no end to taxi violence in the Ugu region where two taxi owners were shot dead at the Lamalia robots in Gamalakhe on Monday last week.

The car the two deceased, Bheki Ngcongco and Maphiwe Shange were travelling in was riddled with bullet holes and covered in blood after the shooting.,

04 April 2023

The widow of Chief Clyde Mnisi of Mpumalanga who was murdered last week, Charlene Felicity Mathews aged 30, has also been brutally killed. She was reportedly gunned down in the early hours of today Tuesday, 04 April 2023 around 01h10am.

1. Gunmen for hire (assassins) are easily found with costs ranging from R40 000.00 up to R 1m. These persons are known as Inkabi's the Zulu word for assassin or hitman.

2. Hits are targeting whistle blowers, political and traditional leaders, taxi bosses, now includes liquidators and big money syndicates.
