

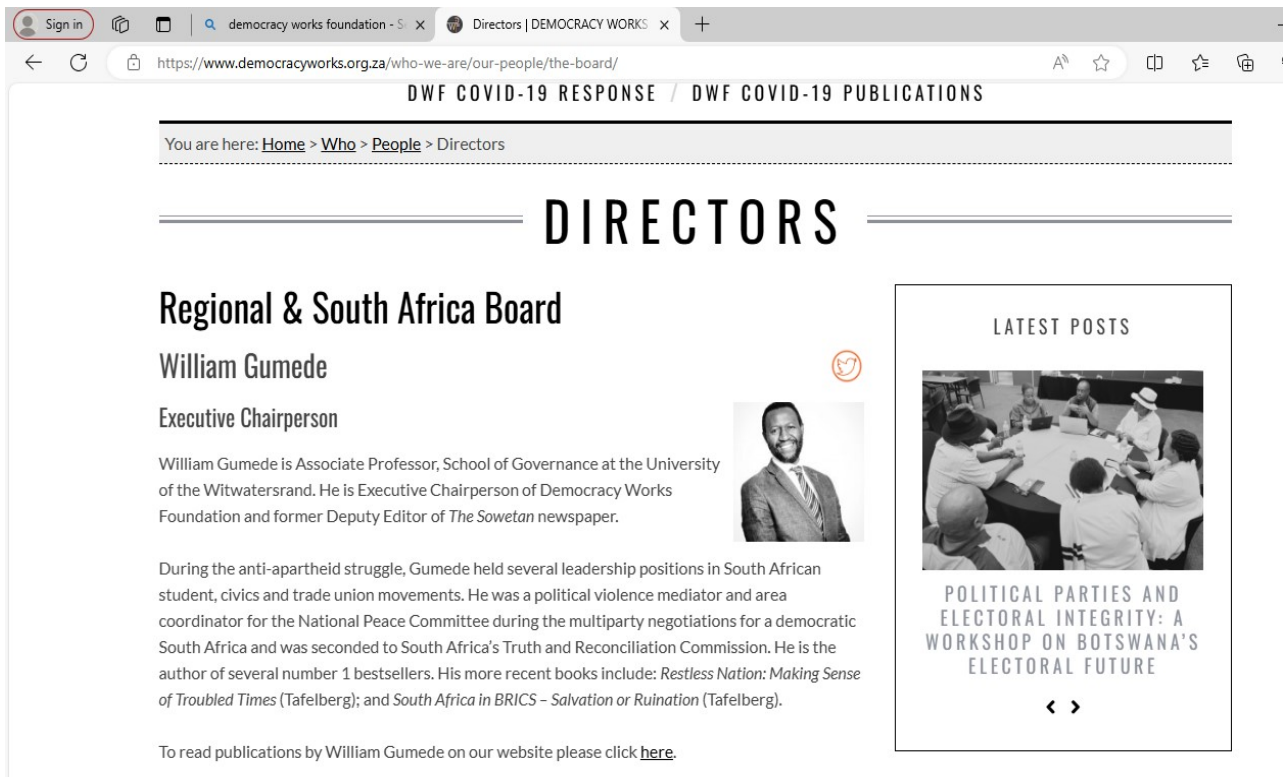

DA leader says Black Tuesday a turning point in our democracy

Note to editors: The following statement was distributed at a press conference held today by Leader of the Democratic Alliance **Helen Zille**, DA Parliamentary Leader **Lindiwe Mazibuko MP**, DA Chief Whip **Watty Watson MP** and DA Federal Chairperson **Dr Wilmot James MP**.

South Africa witnessed an epoch-defining moment this week. Black Tuesday will one day be seen as a turning point in our democracy.

Whatever happens in the months ahead, Tuesday will be remembered as the day that the ANC voted against media freedom - a cornerstone of our democracy.

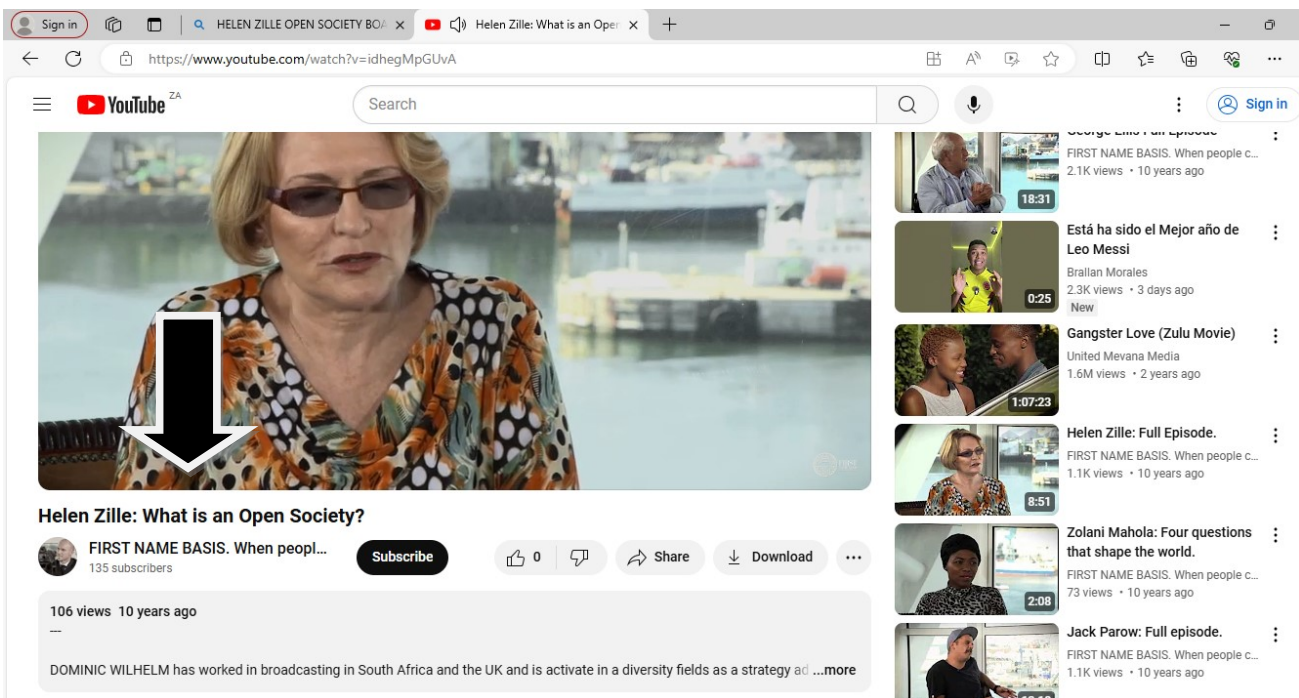
Some people have resigned themselves to a future under a Protection of Information Act, with the censorship implications we thought had died with apartheid.

The Democratic Alliance has not given up. Far from it.

We have fought against the Bill since its inception and we will keep on fighting. This legislation has no place in a free and democratic South Africa.

Before **Helen Zille** began her career in politics she worked as a political correspondent for the Rand Daily Mail, where she covered key political stories, such as the death, in police custody, of black consciousness activist Steve Biko.

From the 1980s onward she became involved in NGOs and activist organizations, including the **Open Society Foundation**, the Independent Media Diversity Trust, and the **Black Sash**.

A group of political parties is seeking the intervention of Chief Justice Raymond Zondo to assist in forming a Government of National Unity (GNU) following the 2024 elections.

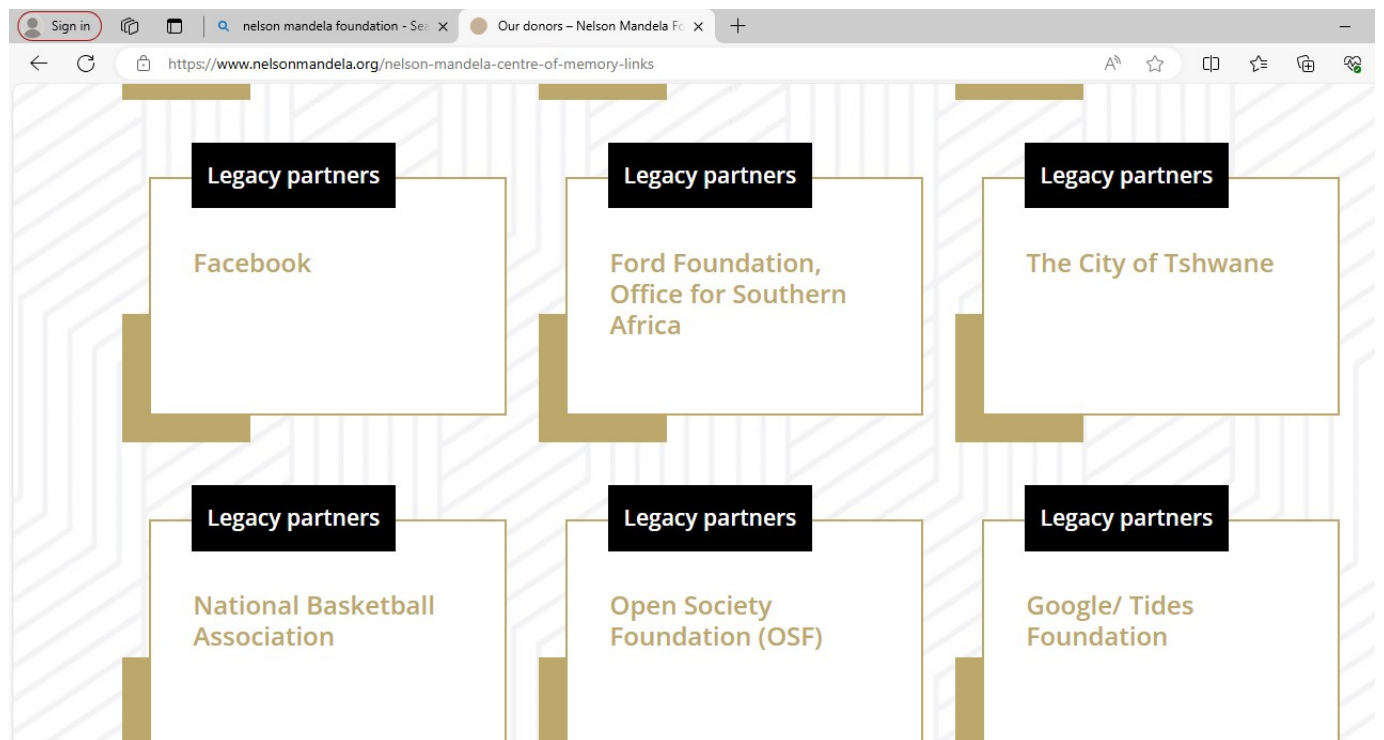
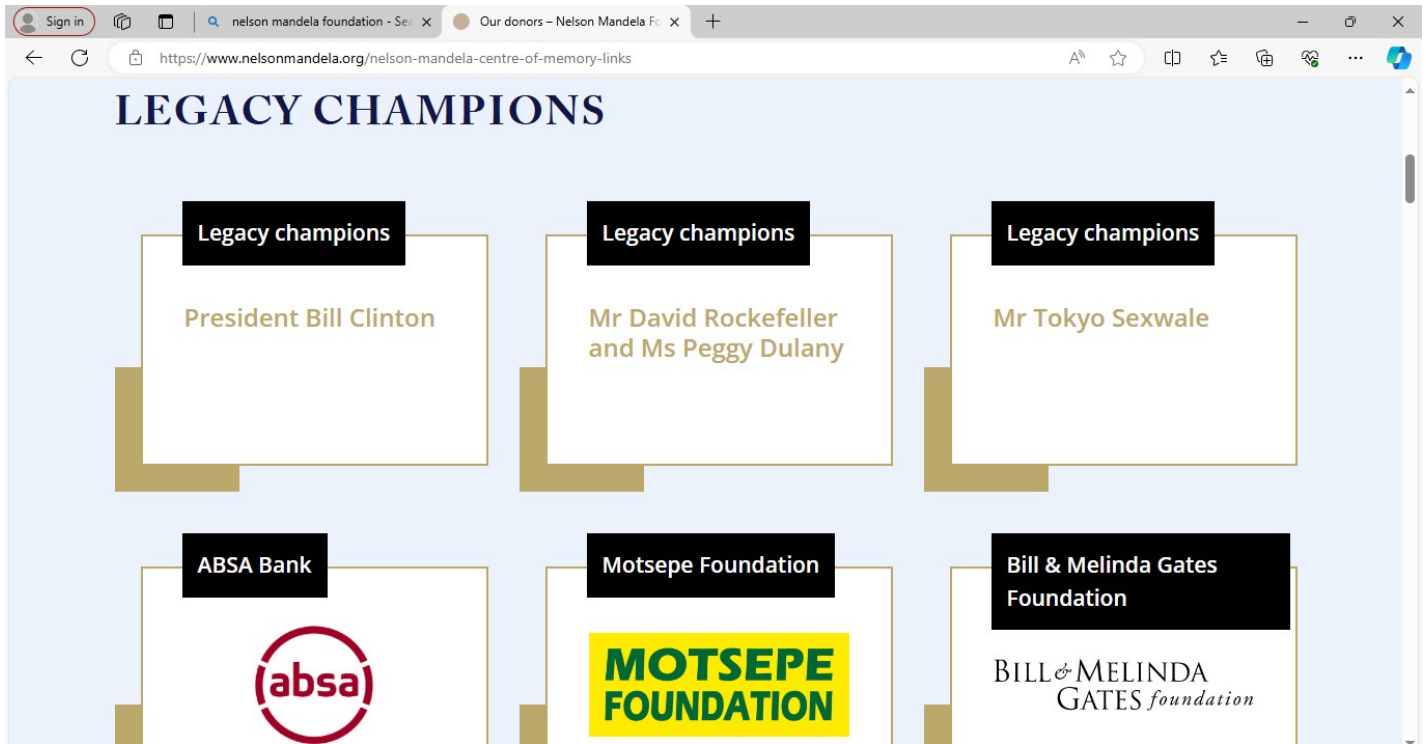

“The purpose of this meeting is to decide on the agenda of any Government of National Unity, which is the preferred option of the biggest party in South Africa, the ANC.

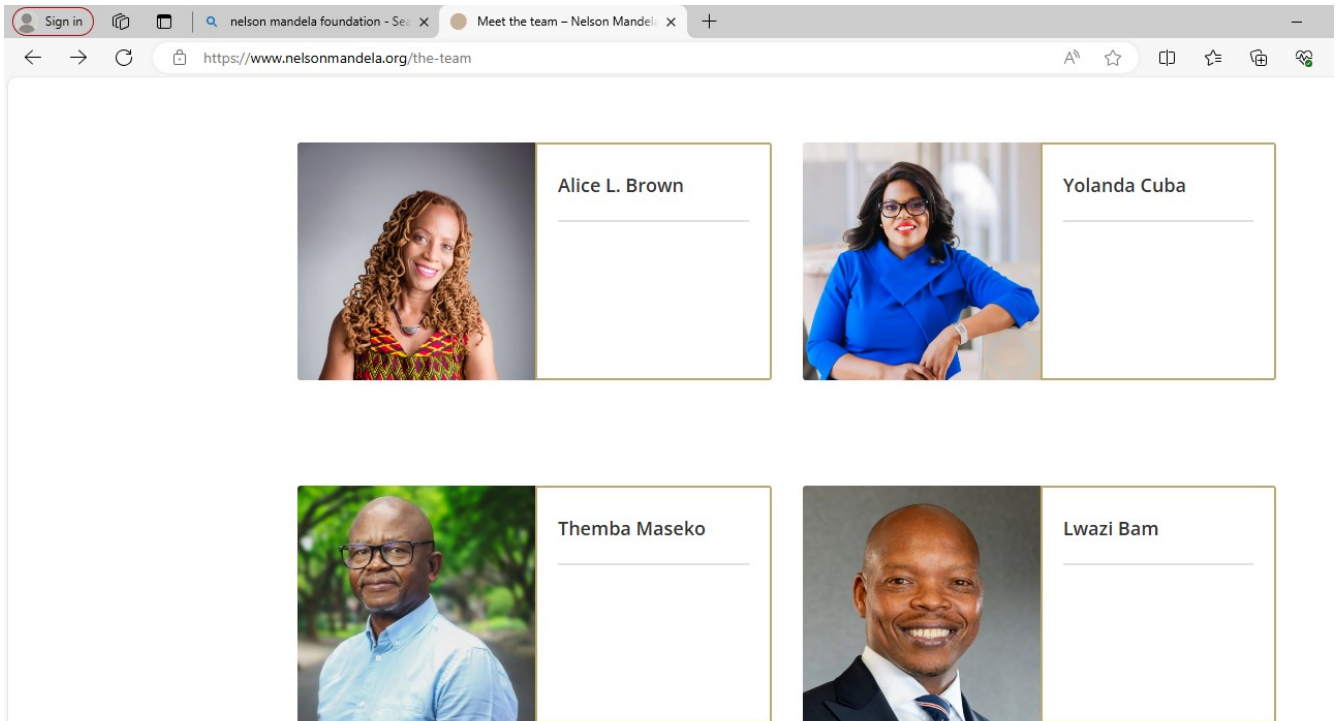

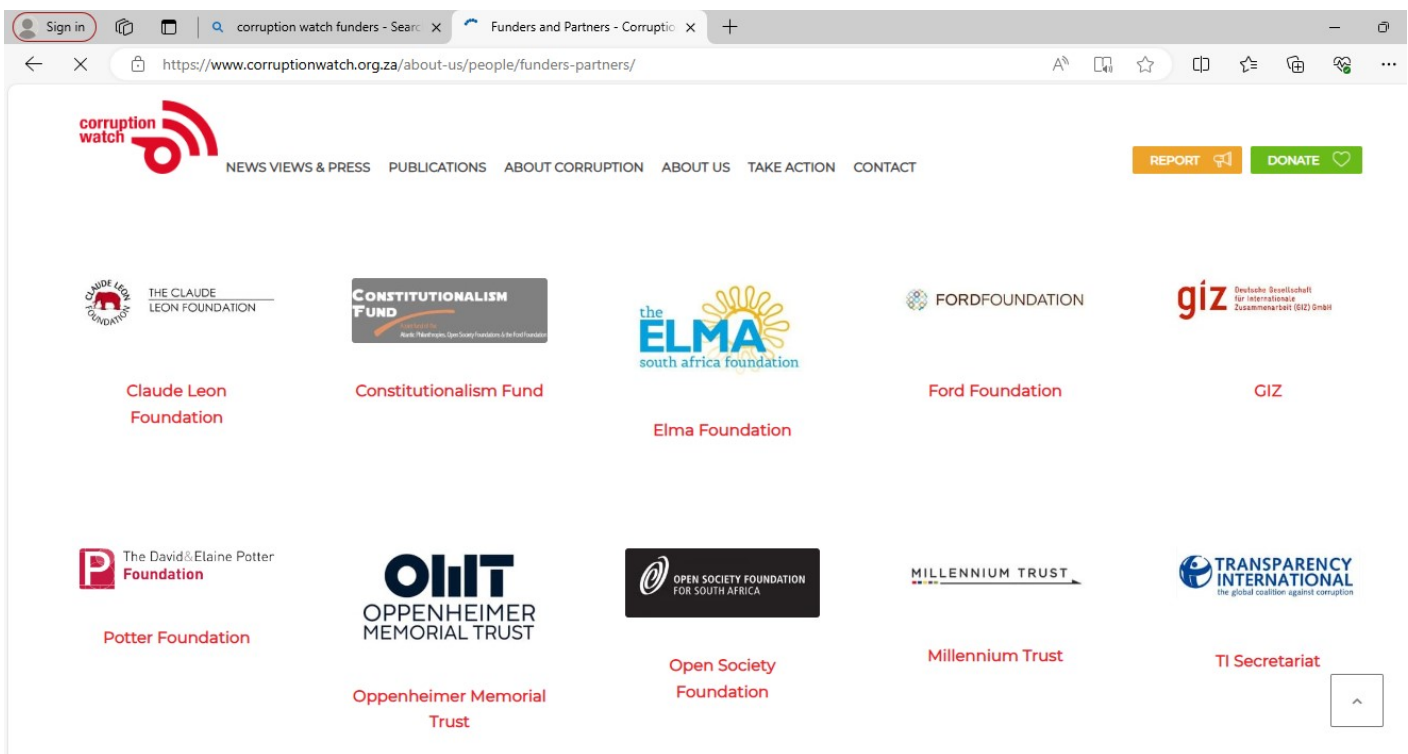

President Cyril Ramaphosa is pleased to announce the appointment of Ms Janet Yetta Love as a Commissioner of the Independent Electoral Commission.

The President has made the appointment in terms of Section 6 of the Electoral Commission Act of 1996 (Act No. 51 of 1996) which directs that the appointment be made on the recommendation of the National Assembly.

Ms Love becomes one of five Commissioners – the number determined by the Act – and is appointed for a term of seven years.

Her appointment follows a series of interviews conducted with candidates by a panel established in terms of Section 6(3) of the Electoral Commission Act.

President Ramaphosa appoints Justice Zondo as Chief Justice

President Cyril Ramaphosa has, in accordance with Section 174(3) of the Constitution, decided to appoint Deputy Chief Justice Raymond Zondo as the next Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa with effect from 1 April 2022.

The President's decision follows consultation with the Judicial Service Commission and leaders of parties in the National Assembly on four nominees for appointment as Chief Justice.

In terms of the Constitution, the Chief Justice is "the head of the judiciary and exercises responsibility over the establishment and monitoring of norms and standards for the exercise of the judicial functions of all courts".

With Justice Zondo assuming the position of Chief Justice, the position of Deputy Chief Justice will become vacant. President Ramaphosa has accordingly indicated his intention, once the new Chief Justice assumes office, to nominate Justice Mandisa Maya for the position of Deputy Chief Justice. This nomination will be subject to the process outlined in Section 174(3) of the Constitution.

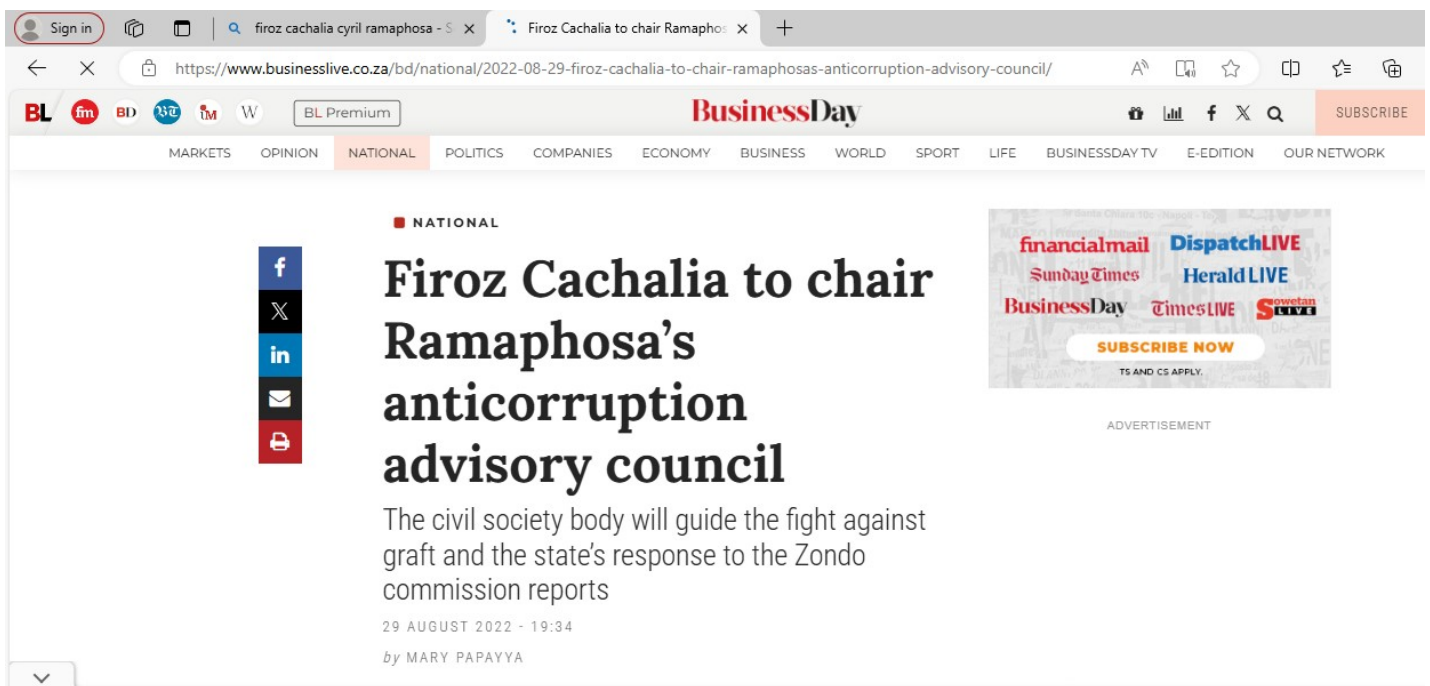
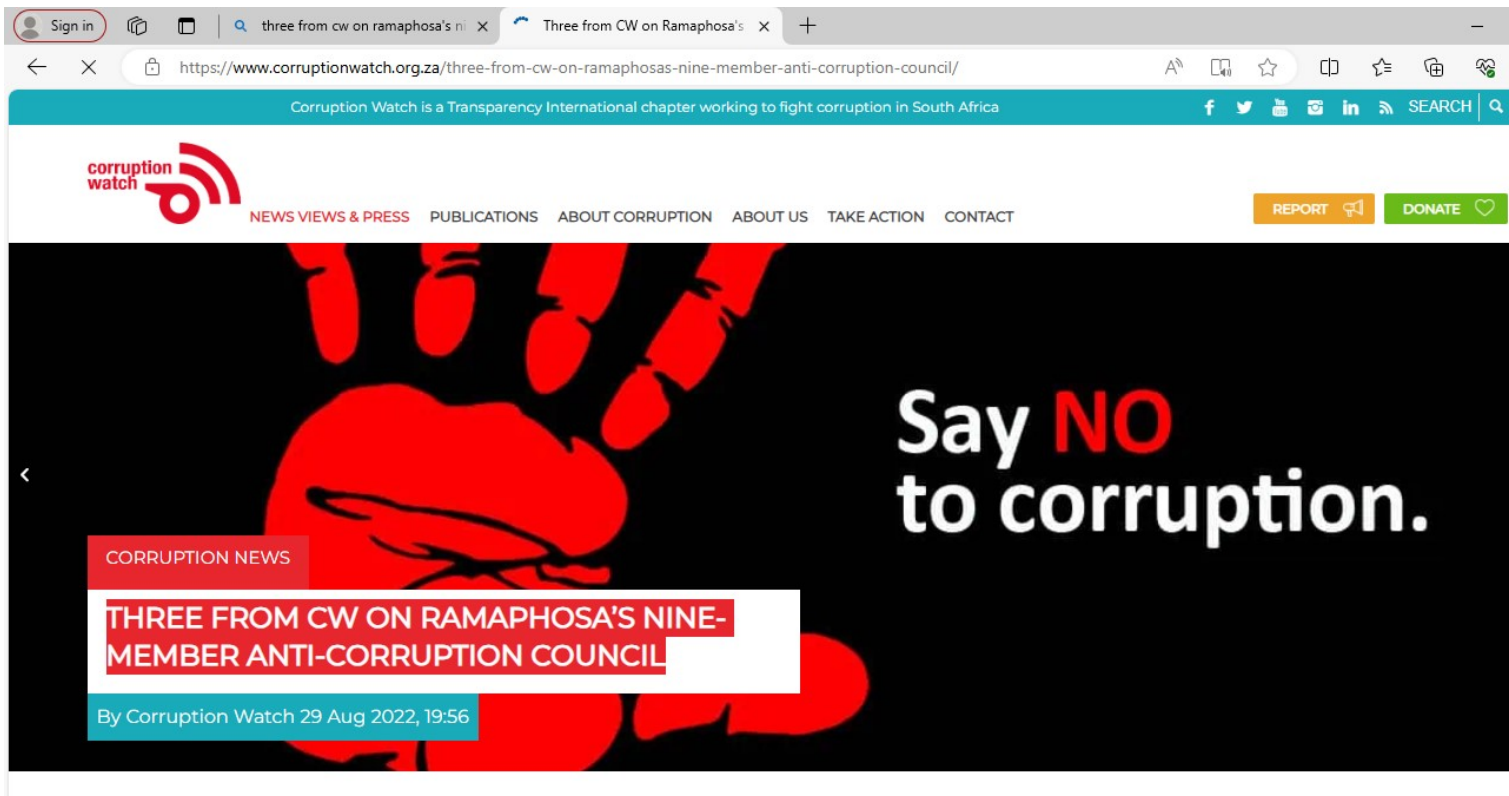
